
This quick reference guide serves as a quick publication with individual control elements. However the quick reference guide does not replace the Owner's manual of your **Superb**.

CHECK ENGINE OIL LEVEL



- a The oil must not be topped up.
- b The oil can be topped up.
- c The oil must be topped up.



WARNING!


When replenishing oil, avoid oil dripping onto hot parts of the engine – risk of fire!



Caution!

The oil level must on no account be above the range **a**. Danger of damaging the catalytic converter.

UNLOCKING AND LOCKING




- 1 Unlocking the vehicle
- 2 Unlocking the boot lid
Long press - Opening the small boot lid
- 3 Locking the vehicle
- 4 Folding out-/folding up of the key

Twindoor - small boot lid



Press on the handle at the underside of the boot lid, the flap is raised automatically.

Twindoor - large boot lid



Press on the handle 1 at the underside of the boot lid.

Wait until the brake light 2 flashes twice.


Press on the handle 3 and at the same time raise the boot lid.

SEATS


Adjusting the front seats

- 1 Adjusting seat in a forward/back direction
- 2 Adjusting height of seat
- 3 Adjusting angle of backrest
- 4 Adjusting lumbar support



Electric setting of the front seats*

- A Adjusting lumbar support
- B Adjusting seat in a forward/back direction and adjusting height of seat
- C Adjusting the inclination of the backrest



Fold the rear seat backrest forwards

Press the release handle **A** and fold the rear seat backrest forwards.



Before folding the rear seats forward, adjust the front seats in such a way that they are not damaged when folding the rear seats forward.

SAFETY


Correct seated position of the driver



WARNING!

Adjust the steering wheel so that the distance between the steering wheel and your chest is at least 25 cm. If you do not maintain this minimum distance, the airbag system will not be able to provide proper protection - when activated it can become a danger to life!

Adjusting belt height



Push the height adjuster upwards or downwards in the desired direction.


After adjusting, pull firmly on the belt to ensure that the height adjuster has correctly locked in place.



WARNING!

Adjust the height of the belt in such a way that the shoulder part of the belt is positioned approximately across the middle of your shoulder, on no account across your neck!

- 1 Rev counter
- 2 Speedometer
- 3 Mode selector switch:
 - Adjusting the hours/minutes
 - Activating/deactivating the second speed in mph*
 - Service Interval - Display of the remaining number of days and the number of kilometers to the next Inspection Service / Reset*
- 4 Coolant temperature gauge*
- 5 Display:
 - with counter for distance driven
 - with Service Interval Display
 - with digital clock
 - with multi-functional indicator
 - with information display*
- 6 Fuel gauge
- 7 Button marked for:
 - Resetting the trip counter for distance driven
 - Activating / deactivating the selected mode


REFUELLING



Opening the fuel filler cap

Press onto the left side of the fuel filler flap.

Unscrew the fuel filler cap anti-clockwise and place it from above on the fuel filler flap.






- A Power window driver's door



You must not adjust the steering wheel when the vehicle is moving!

27 SELECTOR LEVER*

Automatic gearbox*



- P Parklock
- R Reverse gear
- N Neutral (idle position)
- D Drive position for driving forward
- S Position for sporty style of driving

Manual gearshift (Tiptronic)


- + Shifting up

- 4 Recirculated air mode


Control buttons

- A Setting temperature
- B Controlling blower
- C Control for air distribution

! WARNING!

You should not leave the recirculated air mode on over a longer period of time, as the „stale“ air may result in fatigue in the driver and occupants, divert your attention and also cause the windows to mist up. The risk of having an accident increases. Switch the recirculated air mode off as soon as the windows begin misting up.



- 1 Intensive windscreen defroster
 - 2 Air flow to the windscreen
 - 3 Air flow to the upper body
 - 4 Air flow in the footwell
 - 5 Recirculation mode with air quality sensor*
 - 6 Rear window heater
- #### Buttons / control dial
- 7 Setting of the temperature for the left side
 - 8 Automatic mode
 - 9 Switching off Climatronic
 - 10 Setting of the blower speed
 - 11 Button for direct switching on/off of the auxiliary heating*
 - 12 Switching on/off of the temperature setting in the Dual Mode
 - 13 Switching cooling on and off
 - 14 Setting of the temperature for the right side

18 BONNET RELEASE LEVER
